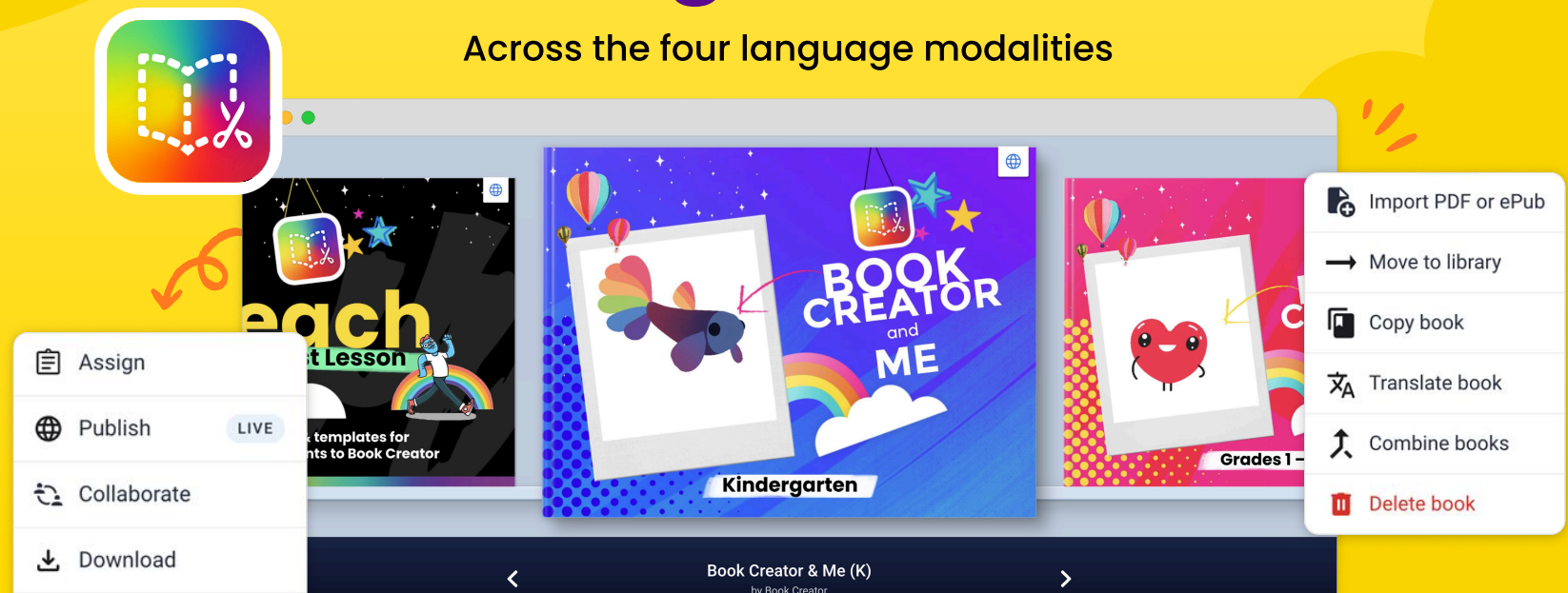


# How Book Creator supports multilingual learners

Across the four language modalities



## Tier I. Strong Core Instruction for All Students



### Listening



**Text-to-speech** allows students to listen to text read aloud to support comprehension.



Audio playback allows students to listen to teacher instructions or peer recordings multiple times.



Video embedded in books allows students to obtain information in a different modality.



### Speaking



The **Recording tool** allows students to explain their thinking and respond to prompts verbally.



The **Video tool** allows students to present ideas and demonstrate understanding.



The **Commenting tool** allows students to participate in discussions & give feedback.



### Reading



**Speech-to-text** allows students to read instructions, content, and peer-created books.



The **Translate tool** allows students to access text in their home language.



**Images** and **Noun Project icons** can support readers with visual cues.



### Writing



The **Text tool** allows students to write explanations, reflections, and responses.



Spelling check support is available, which teachers can control in **library settings**.



The **Pen tool** allows students to annotate and sketch to support written expression.

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## Tier II. Targeted Small-Group Supports



### Focused language practice

- Teachers can create collaborative small-group books so students work together to discuss ideas, build vocabulary, and co-construct responses.
- Teachers can organize peer feedback activities in small groups where students listen to and respond to each other's ideas.

## Tier III. Individualized language support



### Personalized language instruction

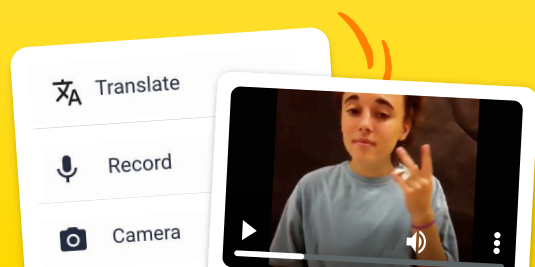
- Teachers can provide individualized templates with simplified instructions and visual cues to support students who need highly structured tasks.
- Teachers can create personalized books for targeted practice, such as vocabulary review, concept explanations, or guided reflections.

## Features for multilingual learners



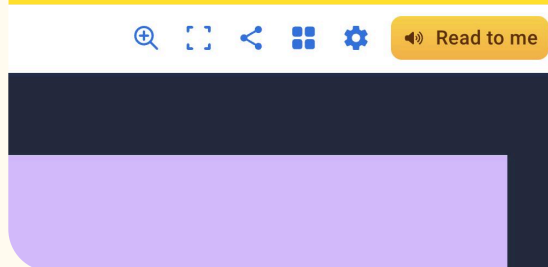
### Translate

Translate books, text, audio and video captions into 130+ languages.



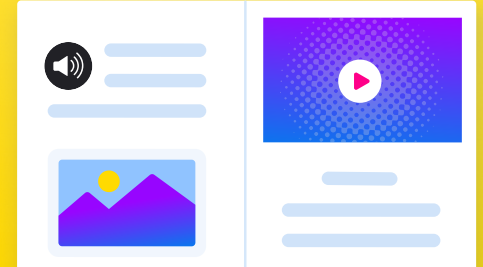
### Read-to-me

Text or pages can be read aloud with word highlighting.



### Voice recording

Record responses to demonstrate understanding despite writing ability.



### Page templates

Provide guided prompts and sentence starters that support language development and academic writing.



### Multimedia books

Teachers can combine text, audio, images, and video so students access content through multiple modes.



### Text tool

Students can practice writing in their home language or English supporting translanguageing.



### Image tool

Students can add images to build vocabulary connections between words and visual meaning.



### Pen tool

Students can label diagrams, sketch ideas, and annotate visuals, supporting comprehension.



### Video recording

Students can explain ideas through spoken language and visual demonstration.

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
