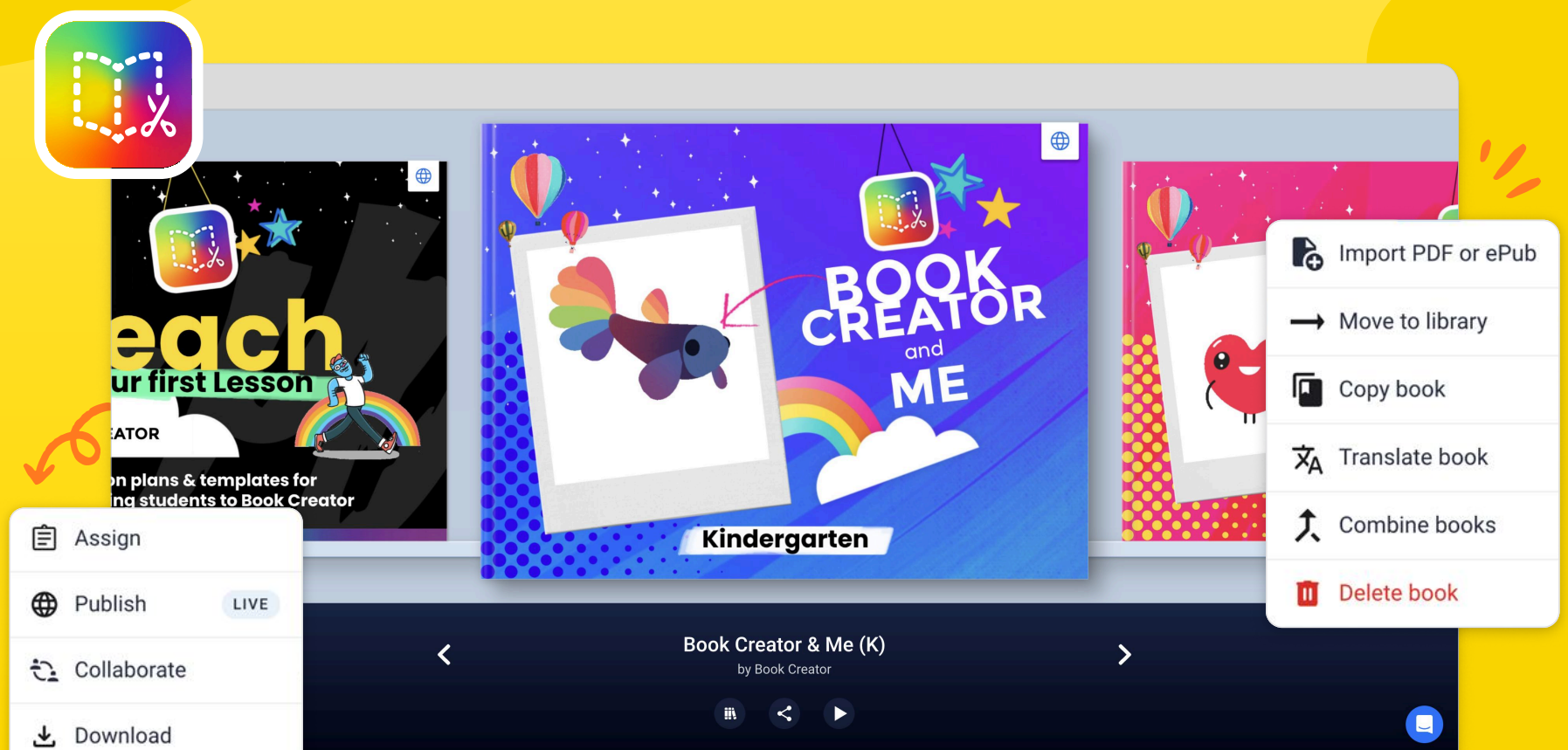

-  Student publishing motivates learners by giving them an authentic audience.

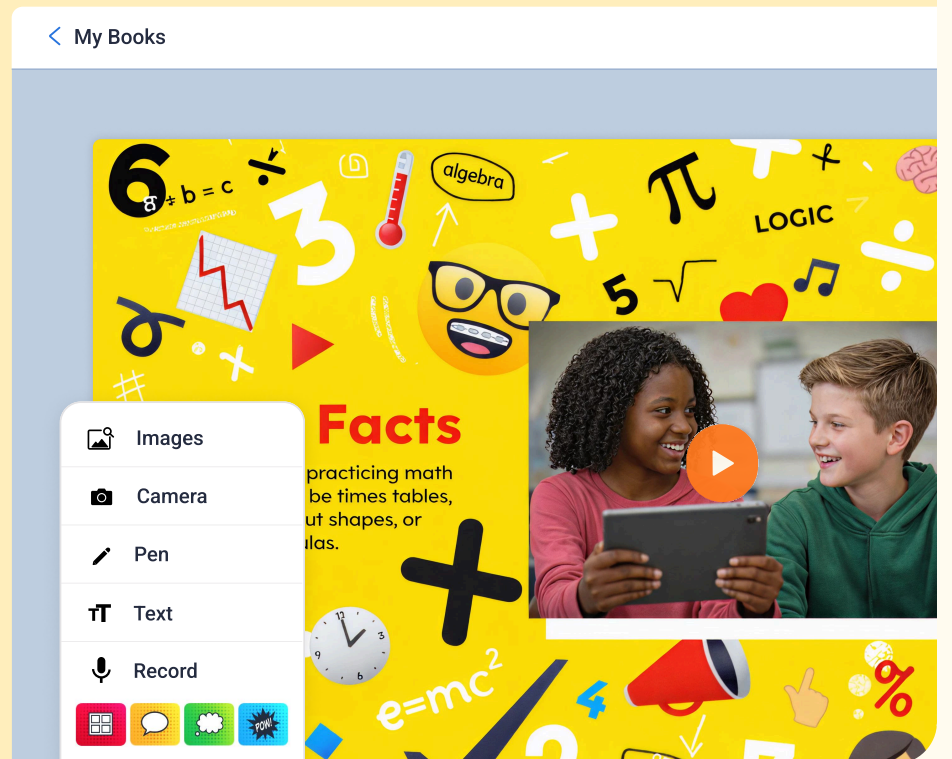

Multiple means of representation

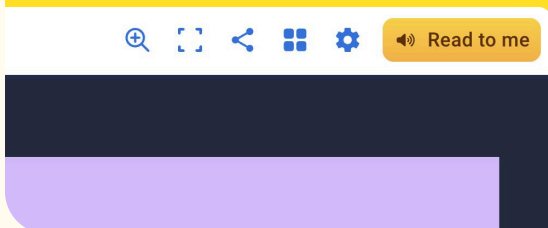
-  Accessible to all: Compatible with keyboard navigation and assistive technologies.

Features for all learners

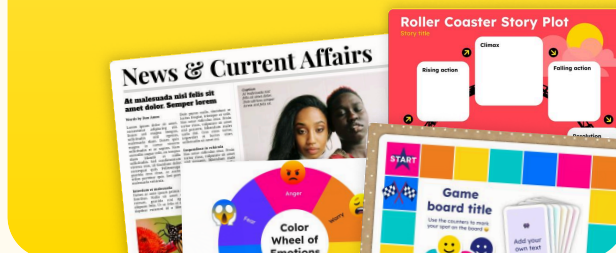
Read-to-me

Narration with synchronized word highlighting, customizable playback speeds, and a variety of voices.



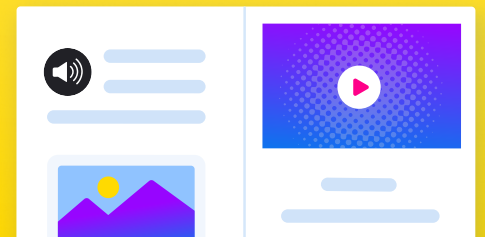
Page templates
