Product Description: Kami Companion is a browser based accessibility product that provides reading, writing, and comprehension support directly within digital content. It enables users to access accessibility tools within web pages to support understanding, engagement, and self-directed learning across a wide range of online materials.

Kami Companion has been evaluated against WCAG 2.1 Level A and AA success criteria through a combination of manual testing, assistive technology testing, and internal accessibility audits.

The majority of accessibility requirements are supported. Some areas of the product do not yet fully meet WCAG 2.1 AA criteria, particularly within dynamic interface components, keyboard interaction patterns, and assistive technology announcements.

Identified issues are actively being addressed as part of ongoing accessibility improvements.

Evaluation Methods Used:

Manual accessibility testing, Keyboard-only navigation testing, screen reader testing (including VoiceOver), automated accessibility scanning tools, and internal QA audits.

Standards Conformance Notes

Kami Companion is evaluated primarily against WCAG 2.1 Level A and AA success criteria, which form the basis for Section 508 and EN 301 549 requirements. WCAG 2.0 and WCAG 2.2 are included for alignment with related and evolving accessibility standards. Conformance statements are based on WCAG 2.1 AA, with additional alignment to related standards where applicable.

Overall Status:

Kami Companion supports the majority of WCAG 2.1 Level A and AA success criteria. Some functionality does not fully meet the criteria, particularly in areas related to keyboard accessibility, focus management, dynamic content announcements, and programmatic structure. Accessibility improvements are ongoing as part of continued product development.
